



Judging Procedures

Judges are selected on the basis of their knowledge, independence, integrity and objectivity. Entry forms will be coded to conceal the entrant's identity from the judges. All entries will be personally inspected by the judges on $\underline{Wednesday}$ & $\underline{Thursday}$, \underline{May} 22^{nd} or 23^{rd} , 2019.

The annual Awards Banquet is scheduled for June 22, 2019. All first place award winners will receive a beautiful plaque with a color photo of the project. Second place awards will receive a recognition plaque.

Entry Rules:

1. PARTICIPATION: Only regular and sustaining members of the North Coast Chapter California Landscape Contractors Association in good standing are eligible to enter.

2. ENTRY FORMS:

- A separate completed entry form is required for each entry. For additional entries, please make your own copies of the entry form.
- Enclose a copy of a Thomas Bros. Map for each entry. Highlight nearest major cross streets on map and write job address on the top page.
- Please legibly type or print all information, and answer all questions clearly and completely. Incomplete entries may be returned for re-submittal.
- Any entry with insufficient information to allow physical access for judging, or with erroneous directions to the entry location, will be withdrawn from competition and entry fees forfeited.
- **3. SCOPE:** All items of the entire contract must be listed. Entry must have at least five (5) items completed by entrant to be judged. Proof of contract may be required.
- **4. PROJECT AGE:** All installation projects must be less than two years old at time of judging and must have been installed after May 1, 2017. Maintenance projects must have been continuously maintained from May 1, 2018 to date of judging.

5. PROJECT QUALIFICATIONS:

- An installation project entered in this competition in a previous year may be entered again if it did not win an award, it is less than two years old, and was installed after May 1, 2017.
- A previously award-winning maintenance project may be entered again, but not in consecutive years.
- Category cost limitations must be adhered to; cost verification may be required.
- Only one "special effect" will be accepted per project.
 Special effects lighting projects may or may not be viewed at night.
- All entries must be located within the geographical confines of the chapter.
- Contractor cannot enter own residence or offices.

- **6. DIGITAL IMAGES:** Each entry must be accompanied by three (3) digital images burned to a CD or e-mailed to Connie: heyconniesalinas@hotmail.com
- Write "Contractor Name" and "Job Name" on the face of CD or emailed digital image.
- <u>Indicate which image you would like to have on the plaque with the title "Plaque Image"</u> if the job wins an award.
- Only horizontal images will be accepted.
- Renovation jobs must have three (3) before images, along with three (3) after images on the CD to qualify.
- CD's will not be returned. Please burn images with at least 800 x 1200 resolution.

7. JUDGING PROCEDURES:

- Entries must be available for judging on May 22 and May 23 between dawn and dusk.
- Judges are selected on the basis of their knowledge, independence, integrity and objectivity. Projects are judged anonymously. All entries will be personally inspected by the judges and evaluated according to quality of workmanship, quality of construction detail, quality of landscape materials and overall appearance. Judges' decisions are final.
- Contractors with entries in the competition must not be on ANY entry site during judging; all entries of any contractor who is present on ANY entry site will be disqualified if contractor or any of his/her employees is present.
- It is the contractor's responsibility to notify the client of the judging dates of May 22 & 23.

8. APPLICATION DEADLINE: April 21, 2019 at 5 pm

- **9. LATE FEE:** Application entries received after closing date will be assessed an additional fee of \$50. Include additional fee as part of your check for each entry. **Late entry deadline is Friday April 28, 2019 at 5:00 pm.**
- **10. PROCESSING AND JUDGING:** No contractor with entries will be involved in any way with the processing or judging of ANY entry (including driving or navigating). Only judges will process final scores and select winning entrants. Judges' decisions are final.



Installation Categories

Single Family Residence:

- 1. Small Residential Installation: Job cost not to exceed \$50,000
- 2. Medium Residential Installation: Job cost from \$50,001 to \$120,000
- 3. Large Residential Installation: Job cost from \$120,001 to \$250,000
- **4. Custom Residential Installation:** Job cost from \$250,001 to \$500,000
- **5. Residential Estate Installation:** Job cost is \$500,001 or more

Commercial Installation:

- **6. Small Commercial Installation:** Job cost not to exceed \$120,000
- 7. Medium Commercial Installation: Job cost from \$120,000 to \$250,000
- **8.** Large Commercial Installation: Job cost of \$250,001 or more

<u>Design/Build:</u> Any project that is both designed **and** installed by the contractor. Contactor must enclose plans and a statement of design intent with entry.

- 9. Small Design/Build: Job cost not to exceed \$150,000
- **10. Medium Design/Build:** Job cost from \$150,001 to \$300,000
- 11. Large Design/Build: Job cost of \$300,001 or more

Other:

- 12. Renovation: A landscape project with a minimum of 35% original landscape undisturbed by contractor(s). No cost limits. Please provide three (3) "before" images printed on paper for judges to review on site with application.
- **13. Special Effects:** Any entry where unique construction methods and materials are used for special artistic effects. Only one entry per project.
- **14. Sustainable Landscape Installation:** An installation that exemplifies a dedication to sustainable principles including, but not limited to: Sustainable landscape design (i.e. creating wildlife habitat). Material use (i.e. native plants, recycled lumber). Installation methods (such as ecosystem preservation during construction), water and energy conservation, organic fertilization, storm water runoff reduction and other elements, which promote sustainable principles. Applicant must demonstrate via written narrative (video or digital photography may accompany the written narrative) how sustainable landscaping was achieved.

Maintenance Categories

Residential Maintenance: Currently and continuously maintained for one year from May 1, 2018

15. Small Residential Maintenance: Job cost not to exceed \$500 per month

16. Medium Residential Maintenance: Job cost \$501 to \$1,200 per month

17. Large Residential Maintenance: Job cost \$1,201 to \$3,000 per month

18. Unlimited Residential Maintenance: Job cost of \$3,001 or more per month

Commercial Maintenance: Currently and continuously maintained for one year from May 1, 2018

19. Small Commercial Maintenance: Monthly fee of \$1,000 or less

20. Medium Commercial Maintenance: Monthly fee \$1,001 to \$3,500

21. Large Commercial Maintenance: Monthly fee \$3,501 to \$7,000

22. Unlimited Commercial Maintenance: Monthly fee of \$7,001 or more

Other: Currently and continuously maintained for one year from May 1, 2018

23. Sustainable Landscape Maintenance: A maintenance account exemplifying a dedication to sustainable principles including, but not limited to: water and energy conservation, fossil fuel use reduction, recycling sitegenerated green waste, Integrated Pest Management (IPM) practices to reduce chemical use, organic fertilization, storm water runoff reduction and/or design or renovation (such as high water use plant replacement, rain garden, etc), which promote sustainable principles. Applicant must demonstrate via written narrative (video or digital images may accompany the written narrative) how the sustainable landscape is being achieved.

Special Award Categories

All Special Awards are awarded at judges' discretion. No first prize will be awarded to an entry that receives a Special Award.

- **24. Excelsior:** Recognizing special talents of any contractor who has been a member of CLCA for less than two years in any category.
- **25. Judges Award:** Any entry that deserves special merit and recognition.
- **26.** Landscape Management Sweepstakes: Awarded to the best entry in the maintenance categories.
- 27. Landscape Installation Sweepstakes: Awarded to the best entry in the installation categories.
